

# 15<sup>th</sup> European Workshop in Phosphorus Chemistry

**This workshop provides ample opportunities for PhD students and early stage researchers to showcase their work to the European community of Phosphorus chemists.**



The long tradition of workshops previously held in Kaiserslautern (2004), Bonn (2005), Leipzig (2006), Zandvoort (2007), Regensburg (2008), Florence (2009), Budapest (2010), Münster (2011), Rennes (2012), Regensburg (2013), Sofia (2014), Kassel (2015), Berlin (2016), and Cluj-Napoca (2017) will be continued with the 15<sup>th</sup> European Workshop in Phosphorus Chemistry in Uppsala, Sweden. This traditional workshop series has contributed to the strong position of the European research community and allowed for a fruitful exchange of ideas, opinions and excellent discussions. The topics of this conference cover organic, inorganic, polymer, and material chemistry as well as biological research.

The focus of the workshop is to support early stage researchers and give them the opportunity to communicate their work to the leading European research groups in phosphorus chemistry. The program includes oral contributions from early stage researchers (15+5 min, 1 presentation per research group), poster sessions (no limitation), and a couple of plenary/keynote lectures from industry and academia. Students will also chair the sessions of oral contributions. Prizes for best posters, oral contributions and chairs will be awarded.

## Uppsala:

Uppsala is the 4<sup>th</sup> largest city in Sweden. It was home to outstanding scientists such as Carl Linnaeus, Anders Jonas Ångström, and Svante Arrhenius. Founded in 1477, Uppsala University is the oldest center of higher education in Scandinavia. Many touristic sites such as the Botanical garden, the Museum Gustavianum and the old library Carolina Rediviva have their roots in academic traditions.

## Travel and Accommodation

Uppsala is conveniently reached by plane (main airport Stockholm - Arlanda) followed by local transport (bus, train, taxi). Accommodation is limited and reservations should be made well in advance. Further details will be posted online.
